4. What was good about Jesus waiting for Lazarus to die instead of going to heal Lazarus right away?

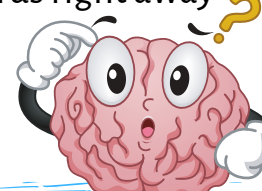
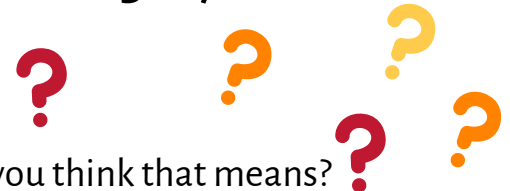
(It brought more attention, honor, and people to God, etc.)

Don't forget to pray!

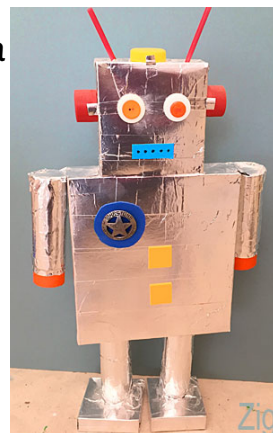
- Find things in your life to thank God for
