Review Questions:



1. What is it called when you trust Jesus, believe in Him, and live like you believe in Him?

(Faith)

(Faith)

3. What are some invisible things we put our faith in every day?

(Gravity, air, our thoughts, people who aren't around, Jesus, etc.)

4. How is faith in Jesus different than faith in anything else?

(Jesus never changes, never lets us down, keeps His promises, and can make us right with God. Nothing else and no one else is like that)

5. What things can you do to keep your faith in Jesus stronger than your faith in anything else?

(Read about Jesus in the Bible, spend time with Him, pray, talk to other people who have faith in Jesus, etc.)



Activity: "Invisible Ink"



Need: half a lemon, Q-Tips, spoon, piece of paper, bowl, lamp, water

First, take your lemon and squeeze ALL the juice into the bowl. Then add a few drops of water. Stir. Dip a Q-Tip into the lemon juice and write a message on the paper. Allow to dry for 3-5 minutes, until you can no longer see it. Then take the message and hold under a lamp for 5-10 minutes or until it turns brown. The heat from the lamp will reveal the secret messages. You will have to be patient.

(maybe see if a hairdryer will help speed it along!)
