




Main Verse:


"Just as the body is dead without breath, so also faith is dead without good works."

Review Questions:



1. What are some things you can do to keep your faith in Jesus healthy?
(Read the Bible, pray, help others, spend time with God, obey parents, tell the truth, sing to God, give our time to God, etc)
2. What do you think is good about keeping your faith healthy?
(It keeps us closer to God, it helps us do even more good things, etc.)
3. If you don't do anything to keep your faith healthy, what do you think will happen?
(Your faith gets weaker, you feel far from God, you aren't motivated to live God's way, etc.)
4. Name one thing you can do this week to grow your faith in Jesus?
(Answers will vary. Examples: read your Bible, pray to God, learn Bible stories about Jesus, etc.)
5. Obeying God is a big thing you can do to keep your faith healthy. What is one thing you can do this week to obey God?
(Answers will vary. Examples: listen to your parents, treat people nicely, tell people about Jesus, etc.)



Activity: "Sword Drill"



Reading our Bible helps us to build our faith in Jesus. It helps us learn more about what it means to follow Jesus. It is a great idea to become more familiar with the Bible to make things easier to find. So everyone get out their own Bibles and we will do what we call a sword drill

Everyone hold up their 'swords' (Bibles) in the air. Someone reads aloud which verse that everyone will be searching for. On the word 'Go' everyone will begin to search for the verse. First person to find the verse will stand up and read it!
