### Get in the Word...

### Main Verse:

"...it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved..." Romans 10:10

### Review Questions:

1. What does "openly declaring or sharing your faith" mean?  
(Share what you believe without hiding it or trying to be quiet)
2. What is it called when you trust Jesus, believe in Him, and live like you believe in Him, too?  
(Faith)
3. What mission does God have for everyone who follows Jesus?  
(Sharing God's Good News about Jesus with the whole world; which means making disciples, or followers of Jesus)
4. What's the difference between knowing about Jesus and actually knowing Jesus?  
(Knowing about Jesus means you only know facts about Him and don't follow Him. Knowing Jesus means you trust Him, follow Him, and you've given your whole life to Him)
5. What is good about sharing your faith in Jesus?  
(Others can learn about Jesus from you, and they might choose to have faith in Him, too)
6. What can you do this week to share your faith?  
(Talk about Jesus, invite people to online church, help out, be kind, share Bible verses, etc.)
7. If you share your faith with someone and they don't believe, what can you do for them?  
(Love them, be kind, don't give up, pray for them, etc.)



## Activity: "Let's Report" Don't forget to pray!

Grab your notebook and let's do some reporting...  
Find some people that you can ask (or interview)  
about how they came to know and follow Jesus.  
Ask them questions like...

How long have you been a follower of Jesus?  
How did you come to be a follower of Jesus?



What is something important you think I should know?

Even come up with some of your own questions to ask.

We can learn lots from other believers.  
Maybe you'd like to write down their stories.  
Let's learn more about others' faith in Jesus.
