Memory Verse

"God's grace has saved you because of your faith in Christ. Your salvation doesn't come from anything you do. It is God's gift."

Ephesians 2:8, NIV

Watch this week's video on MWKidsWorld.ca or our Facebook page and discuss these questions as a family:

Jesus is a gift for everybody. For you, for me, for people in other countries, for people with every colour of skin, hair, and eyes, no matter how many times we mess up. When it comes to Jesus, everybody's in.

1. In your words, what do you think grace is?

(God's love, God's forgiveness, getting something you don't deserve, a gift.)

2. Who messes up? Who makes mistakes?

(Everyone--moms, dads, stepparents, teachers, friends, etc.)

3. True or false? God expects me to do the right thing all the time, and then He will let me have a relationship with Him?

(False! Our relationship with God isn't based on what we do. It's about what Jesus has done. When we understand that Jesus came as a gift, and we put our trust in Him as Saviour, we can have a relationship with God forever.)

4. So, who is Jesus and what did He do for us?

(Jesus is God's Son. Jesus was sent by God to give His life so that we could have a relationship with God now and forever.)

5. How can you share the gift of Jesus with others?

(Pray for them to know Jesus, talk to them about Jesus, show Jesus' love to them in your words and actions, etc.)

"God, thank You for the gift of Your Son, Jesus. Because Jesus came to Earth, lived a perfect life, and died for us, we can be in Your family forever. That's incredible that's the gift of grace. And You offer that gift to everybody. All we have to do is have faith in You. Help us to remember that You love us no matter what—even when we mess up. Amen."

Activity "Gift Wrap Relay"



Need: an empty box, wrapping paper, tape.

For this game, families split into two teams. The first person from the team must wrap the box and pass their wrapped gift to their teammate, who must then unwrap and re-wrap the box as quickly as possible. Pass to the next person and repeat! The team who can wrap, unwrap, and re-wrap their box the most in a set time limit or x amount of times is the winner!

While the gift box may be empty, the gift of Jesus can always be given to someone around us and it is always full of life!
