Activity:

"Masterpiece Slap!"



Need: a name tag for each kid.

Read out a word that some people might believe describes them. If it's a good, godly label that you should always believe, slap your label and say "Masterpiece!" If it's not something you should believe about yourself, make an "X" with your arms and say "Nope!"

Extra ...

"Child of God Mirror"

Materials needed: cardboard to be a frame, glue, silver mirror boards (a small mirror or even tin foil will work), large craft stick.

Glue the mirror or tin foil to the cardboard and glue/tape the cardboard to the craft stick. You can decorate the frame of your mirror however you want! Maybe above the mirror itself, you can write "I am God's Masterpiece!" or "I am a child of God!" so that every time you look into the mirror, you'll be reminded of that truth!

If you can't make a mirror, you can always decorate one you already have!
