Operational Plan For Covid-19

The following plan has been created to ensure the health and safety of families coming to Kids' World while providing a fun, Christ-filled environment for your child to learn and grow spiritually. Updated: September 1, 2020

By entering Moncton Wesleyan premises, you are agreeing that you and all attending from your household are in good health, have not travelled outside the Atlantic Bubble within the past 14 days, and have not been in direct contact with someone exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms. If you or a member of your household are unwell, have cold or influenza, or COVID-19 symptoms, you are expected to follow all government recommendations and self-isolate. Please do not bring your child to Kids' World if they are experiencing any of the following symptoms:

- Fever above 38 degrees Celsius, a cough, difficulty breathing, runny nose, sore throat, headache, onset of new fatigue, a new onset of muscle pain, diarrhea, loss of sense of taste, loss of sense of smell, purple markings on fingers and toes.
- If a child develops symptoms while in our care we will immediately remove the child and take them to a holding station in the atrium to await the arrival of parents.

Upon Entering our Building:

- To be a part of Sunday morning Kids' World all families must enter through the right-hand, front doors of our church building. Those guests that do not have families will enter through the left-hand front doors.
- Please social distance (6 feet) at all times with people outside your family bubble. There will be indicators on the floor that will help guide you.
- Once inside you will be directed to one of 3 registration lines in the atrium where you will register yourself into the Celebration Center and your children into their appropriate pods.
- Please follow the signage that will help with directional flow:
 - o Nursery and Preschool will both enter at our main Kids World entrance. Nursery will exit at our main washroom hallway (directly across from nursery) and Preschool will exit at the end of the hall through the far stairwell. You will find signs to help you with exiting.
 - o Grade 4/5 will enter through our main Kids' World entrance but must exit the far hallway on the top floor to the far stairwell. You will find signs to help you with exiting.
- Our registration team will be required to wear a mask when serving our families.
- Stickers will be passed to you by a registration team member.
- All children (excluding those in nursery) will be asked to use hand sanitizer at the registration desk.

- Masks are to be worn by adults and children age 11 and up upon entering the Kids' World area.
- Please note this important change:
 - o **ALL children (including grades 3-5) will need to be picked up with the coinciding parents' sticker.**

Kids' World - Elementary:

- Elementary age children will be separated into 'team pods' of 15 children that will be social distanced from the other pods.
- Pod leaders will stay with their pods at all times.
- Pods will be managed as follows:
 - o Kindergarten / Grade 1 boys – Green Bombs
 - o Kindergarten / Grade 1 girls – Yellow Slugs
 - o Grade 2 / Grade 3 boys – Red Claws
 - o Grade 2 / Grade 3 girls – Purple Gorillas
 - o Grade 4 / Grade 5 boys – Black Dragons
 - o Grade 4 / Grade 5 girls – Blue Wahoos
- A team name/color is designated to each pod and will help with directional flow. Please follow the colored dots on the floor to and from our pick up/drop off area that coincides with your pod team.
- Once a child has been assigned to a pod they are not permitted to change.
- Within the pod children and leaders are not required to wear masks but they are most welcome if that is desired.
- Washrooms for kindergarten through grade 3 are located on the bottom floor.
- Washrooms for grade 4-5 are on the top floor in the hall.
- When needed a leader will escort them to the washroom and will wait outside the door as they allow one child in at a time.
- Hand washing for each child will be required and with the direction of our leaders, children will be asked to wipe down areas they touched once they are finished.
- Masks are worn by our volunteers and staff when physical distancing outside of their team is not possible.
- Snacks and food will not be served. Prepackaged candy may at times be sent home as reward but are encouraged to be opened once they have left Kids' World.
- All surfaces are sanitized prior to the arrival of our kids.
- Parents or any outside people are not permitted to enter into Kids' World.

Pre-school:

- Preschool format will consist of 2 pods of 15 children, of mixed ages, in two separate classrooms. These groups will be kept separate from others.
- Our preschool children ages 2-4 will pod according to their arrival (not according to ages). This means that family members within the preschool age bracket will be placed together if possible.
- Elementary, preschool and nursery separate departments (no mixing).
- Parents are not permitted to enter into the classrooms.
- Snacks and food will not be served. Please refrain from sending cups and snacks with your child.
- Our pre-school room has its own washroom and is sanitized after each use. Thorough hand washing will occur after each use.

- Masks are not required within the confines of each pod but are welcome if an individual wishes to do so.

Nursery:

- Toddlers 12-24 months will have a maximum of 15 children while our infant side will have a maximum of 6.
- Personal snacks and drinks will not be permitted during this time.
- Please note that only the leaders that are assigned to the pod will be permitted to enter into the nursery area.
- The Bellies and Bottoms room will be closed at this time. Change tables are available in our main atrium washrooms.

Exit and Pick Up:

- Once church service is over parents please pick up your child where they were dropped off and follow the signs to exit
- Nursery will exit at the main washroom hallway (directly across from the nursery)
- Preschool will exit at the end of the hall through the stairwell beside room 160.
- Kindergarten to grade 3 will exit as they came in (please ensure to follow the flow of traffic for entering and exiting)
- Grade 4/5 will exit via the top floor hallway to the stairwell beside Room 254.
- Once at the appropriate pick up door the parent will provide the name(s) and matching sticker label for each child. A team member will call the name of each child and bring them to the door.
- Once parents have their child/children they are then directed to the building exit. Lingered is not encouraged inside the building.
