### Memory Verse

(Answers will vary.)
2. Do you have any friends who have helped you when you needed it? Tell me about it.  
(Answers will vary.)

(No. We should always love other people.)
4. Can you talk about a situation when you helped your friend(s) when they needed help?  
(Answers will vary.)
5. Sometimes when we're upset, it can be hard to show love to others. How can we still do that even when it's hard?  
(Pray, ask Jesus for help, talk about why you're upset, etc.)

"God, thank You for being our Friend forever. Thank You for loving us no matter what. Help us to be a friend like Jonathan. Help us to be loyal, honest, and good to the people You have put in our lives. We love You. In Jesus' Name. Amen."

## Activity: "Memory Verse Hopscotch"
