

Moncton Wesleyan Kids' World

Operational Plan For Covid-19

Updated November 16, 2020

The following plan has been created to ensure the health and safety of families coming to Kids' World while providing a fun, Christ-filled environment for your child to learn and grow spiritually.

By entering Moncton Wesleyan premises, you are agreeing that you and all attending from your household are in good health, have not travelled outside the Atlantic Bubble within the past 14 days, and have not been in direct contact with someone exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms. Please stay home if you are exhibiting more than one symptom. If only one symptom is present (not including fever) a no touch temperature check must be passed for admission into Kids' World. If you or a member of your household is unwell, you are expected to follow all government recommendations and self-isolate. Entry and Drop Off:

- To be a part of Sunday morning Kids' World all families must enter through the right-hand, front doors of our church building. Other church attenders will enter through the left-hand front doors.
- Please social distance (6 feet) at all times with people outside your family bubble. There will be indicators on the floor that will help guide you.
- Once inside you will be directed to one of 3 registration lines in the atrium at the Kids' World entrance where you will register yourself into the Celebration Center and your children into their appropriate pods.
- Our registration team will be required to wear a mask when serving our families.
- Stickers will be passed to you by a registration team member.
- All children (excluding those in nursery) will be asked to use hand sanitizer at the registration desk.
- Masks are to be worn by adults and children 3 years and up upon entering the building and only when inside their pods will they be allowed to remove them. Any movement outside of these pods a person must wear their mask.
- All surfaces are sanitized prior to the arrival of our kids.
- **ALL children (including grades 3-5) will need to be picked up with the coinciding parents' sticker.**

Elementary (K-Grade 5):

- Elementary age children will be separated into 'team pods' of 15 children that will be socially distanced from the other pods.
- Pod leaders will stay with their pods at all times.
- Pods will be managed and identified as follows:
 - o Kindergarten / Grade 1 boys – Green Bombs
 - o Kindergarten / Grade 1 girls – Yellow Slugs
 - o Grade 2 / Grade 3 boys – Red Crabs
 - o Grade 2 / Grade 3 girls – Purple Gorillas
 - o Grade 4 / Grade 5 boys – Black Dragons
 - o Grade 4 / Grade 5 girls – Blue Wahoos

- Follow the coloured dots on the floor for drop off and pick up.
- Once a child has been assigned to a pod they are not permitted to change.
- Within the pod, children and leaders are not required to wear masks but they can if they wish to.
- Washrooms for kindergarten through grade 3 are located on the basement floor.
- Washrooms for grade 4-5 are on the top floor in the hall.
- When needed, a leader will escort them to the washroom and will wait outside the door as they allow one child in at a time. (masks will be worn in the hallway) Masks are worn by our volunteers and staff when not inside their pods.
- Hand washing and hand sanitizing for each child will be required.
- Prepackaged food may be served for special occasions. They will all be individually packaged and will take into consideration allergies of each child. When food is being served it will be indicated clearly at our check in station.
- Prepackaged candy may at times be sent home as reward.

Pre-school (ages 2-4 years):

- Preschool format will consist of 2 pods of 15 children, of mixed ages, in two separate classrooms. These groups will be kept separate from others.
- Pods will be determined by arrival time (not according to age). This means that family members in this age group will be placed together if possible.
- Snacks and food will not be served. Please refrain from sending cups and snacks with your child.
- Our preschool room has its own washroom. Thorough hand washing will occur after each use.
- Within the pod, children and leaders are not required to wear masks but they can if they wish to. Masks are worn by our volunteers and staff when not inside their pods.
- Only the leaders that are assigned to the pod will be permitted to enter into the classroom.

Nursery (ages 0-24 months):

- Toddlers 12-24 months will have a maximum of 15 children while our infant side will have a maximum of 6.
- Personal snacks and drinks will not be permitted during this time.
- Only the leaders that are assigned to the pod will be permitted to enter into the nursery area.
- The Bellies and Bottoms room will be closed at this time. Change tables are available in our main atrium washrooms.

Exit and Pick Up:

- Please pick up your child where they were dropped off and follow the signs to exit.
- Nursery will exit at the main washroom hallway (directly across from the nursery)
- Preschool will exit at the end of the hall through the stairwell beside room 160.
- Kindergarten to grade 3 will exit at the same door they came in.
- Grade 4/5 will exit via the top floor hallway to the stairwell beside Room 254.
- Once at the appropriate pick up door the parent will provide the name(s) and matching sticker label for each child. A team member will call the name of each child and bring them to the door.
- Once you have picked up your child, please exit the building.
